MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Pinon Park Pool Association Members,

Thank you to the members who came to the Annual Meeting on September 8, 2018. The Board had made a plea for more Board Members, and you responded! Neil Stoddard and Martin Schauer agreed to serve one more year after their terms had expired. Allison Zane, Robert Mincey, Esther Brunette and Eric Nelson agreed to serve on the Board. All six candidates were unanimously elected, and now there are seven Board Members! The three Board Members for 2017-2018, who wore numerous hats, are delighted to share the load with the new Board Members. For those who stayed after the Annual Meeting to help during the Closing Work Party, THANK YOU! All of the pool equipment was removed, cleaned and stored in the garage... and the heavy winter cover placed on the pool. Having many hands available made putting the pool cover on much easier! We hope to have your help again at the pre-season work parties and on-going maintenance of the pool facility during the summer months.

Though the pool is closed for the rest of the year until next May, the Board is working on hiring staff for the 2019 swimming season, actively recruiting new members through some public relation events, established a calendar for the 2019 season and updated forms. We had 92 membership families in 2018, and barely squeaked by financially. We need about 120 members or more in order to insure we can pay our staff, staff related taxes, utility bills, necessary insurance policies and maintenance bills. We want to build up the fund for purchasing and installing a new heater, replace other equipment such as dilapidated chaise lounges, life guard rescue tubes and the summer pool cover, plus set aside funds to buy back the pool property from the current owner. The Board will be direct mailing postcards again and advertising in local media, but the word of mouth is the best method of gaining more pool memberships. Will you help the Board spread the word that Pinon Park Pool is a great place to come swim with your family during the summer months?

Speaking of memberships, now is not too soon to submit your payment for the 2019 season! The graduated membership fees will remain the same. The membership forms and waivers are attached to this letter. The pool website also has the membership forms and necessary waiver forms for the 2019 season for you or your friends to download. Does a grandparent need an idea for a Christmas or Hanukkah present, such as purchasing a pool membership for your family? A pool membership is cheaper than many vacation venues! We hope to see you and your family at Pinon Park Pool, having a fantastic summer swimming in the 82 degrees Fahrenheit, crystal-clear water!

- Register by returning completed Membership and Liability Forms.
- Pay with PayPal (fee applies), cash, check, or set up fee-free payment plan.
- For 2018 members, **membership fees are due by May 11, 2019** (\$50 late fee applies from May 26, 2019).
