MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Welcome to the 2013 Summer Season at Pinon Park Pool! We hope you enjoyed your winter and are looking forward to the warm weather and another fun summer at our pool.

As you may know, the pool is faced with a number of financial challenges this year. We have a budget shortfall of over \$16,000 from last year, while the county is planning to *triple* our sewer rates. Our projected expenses for the year are:

- Facilities & equipment - \$18,000
- Operations & chemical supplies - \$12,000
- Insurance & Property Tax - \$14,000
- Payroll - \$35,000

Because of our debts and increasing operating costs, we will save money by opening the pool later in the mornings. This will reduce our payroll expenses and heating costs.

Also included in the membership package is a vote on either 1) a one-time special assessment of \$60 per membership or 2) closing the pool early. This is to correct our budget overrun from last season. Please return your ballot along with the membership form.

Because Memorial Day is so early this year, we are planning to open after school ends on Saturday, June 1. It's a great way to celebrate the start of summer vacation! We are also planning a lot of fun activities over the summer, including our weekly late night swims and ice cream parties.

Please make sure that our Membership Chair has your current email address so that we may keep you updated on pool news, and, when necessary, pool closings due to the weather. Pool information may also be found on our website at www.pinonpool.com.

2013 MEMBERSHIP FEES

Just as last year, there are three types of memberships, based on how many members of your household want to join the pool. The fee breakdown will be:

- One person membership: \$200 plus 5 guest passes
- Two person membership: \$325 plus 10 guest passes
- Family membership: \$450 plus 20 guest passes

The volunteer fee is \$75.00.

Only family members who reside with the owner of the membership are eligible for swimming privileges. Out-of-town guests staying with a pool member are not required to use a guest pass to visit the pool. Neighbors, friends, family members living in another home in town, etc. will be considered guests and require a guest pass. These regulations will be strictly enforced during the 2013 season. Additional guest passes may be purchased from the Membership Chair.

MEMBERSHIP RENTALS AND TRANSFERS

Since we have ample memberships available, we will no longer facilitate the rental or transfer memberships.

METHOD OF PAYMENT

Pinon Park Pool will accept payment of membership and volunteer fees by check or credit card. Checks should be made payable to *Pinon Park Pool Association*.

A payment plan may also be set up for an additional \$15 processing fee. The first two payments must be made prior to Opening Day. The third payment is due by June 30, 2013. If the final payment is not received by this date, the membership will be suspended until payment is received.

All payments or payment plans must be made prior to Opening Day. If payment is not received, or a payment plan established by May 31, 2013, your membership will be suspended until payment is received, and you will not be admitted to the pool.

VOLUNTEER HOURS AND FEES

Each pool membership is required to complete six hours of volunteer time. The volunteer fee is \$75 (\$12.50 per hour) per membership.

Although we would prefer to have your time and effort, we understand that, for some, this is not possible. If you know ahead of time that you will not be able to fulfill the six-hour requirement, please indicate this on your assessment form. Your \$75 volunteer fee will be deposited to assist in completing jobs needed to prepare for Opening Day. If you do not complete your volunteer time, your fee will be deposited at the end of the season.

Special circumstances regarding the volunteer requirement may be taken into consideration. Please contact the Membership Chair for more information.

WORK PARTIES

Work parties will be held on Friday, May 3; Saturday, May 4; Saturday, May 11; and Saturday, May 18. Jobs include cleaning bathrooms, clearing the garage area, pulling weeds, cleaning deck furniture, and cleaning and filling the pool. We also need to do some landscaping work and would appreciate donations of flowers to spruce up the front of the pool.

SWIM LESSONS

Swim lessons will be held on the following dates from 9:30 am – 10:15 am:

- June 10 – June 14
- June 24 – June 28
- July 8 – July 12
- July 22 – July 26

Lessons cost \$25 for members and \$35 for non- members. Payments must be received prior to the start of class. If payment is not received, participation will be denied. Classes must have at least five participants signed up. First priority will be given to pool members. Signup sheets will be posted in the lobby. More information may be found on the pool website.

SPECIAL EVENTS

The pool will host several special activities throughout the 2013 season, including late night swims, ice cream parties, and the Annual 4th of July festivities. Check out the website for details.
