*MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT*

Welcome to another season at the pool! The Pinon Park Pool is planning to open at the end of May for the 2015 swimming season. The pool was forced to close early last season due to an insufficient number of staff available with school resuming and the desire to close the season financially sound. However, we still experienced a \$5000 shortfall for last season, even with the implementation of cost-cutting efforts. Our projected expenses for 2015 are:

Facilities & equipment-\$23,000  
 Operations & chemical supplies-\$10,000  
 Insurance & Property tax-\$14,000  
 Payroll-\$27,000

Our financial goal is to greatly increase membership (we had 140 last year and bylaws allow 250), and continue with cost-cutting measures, so that we can pay off the loan the pool has been carrying for several years. Then we can address the need for a new pump and repainting the pool. To increase recruitment, there is no planned fee increase this year. Also, if you refer a friend and they join the pool this year, the pool will give you \$100 toward your next assessment.

In the left side panel, you will note we have four new board members: Leilani Christensen, Daria Cuthbertson, Leeann Foster and Amy Woods. Several of the current board members have served for a number of years, so if you are interested in becoming a board member in 2016, please contact our current board. PPP Association is a member owned, 501-c-7, non-profit, organization that needs your help to maintain the friendly, family atmosphere that has characterized PPP throughout the years.

**2015 MEMBERSHIP FEES**

There are three types of memberships, based on how many members of your household want to join the pool. The fee breakdown will be:

- Single membership (includes 5 guest passes)..... \$200
- Double membership (includes 10 guest passes)..... \$325
- Family membership (includes 20 guest passes)..... \$450

The volunteer fee is \$75.00.

*To ensure that children are properly supervised and to meet insurance requirements, we require that at least ONE member per membership is age 18 or over. Children under the age of 12 should have a parent or legal guardian with them at the pool at all times.*

Only family members who reside with the owner of the membership are eligible for swimming privileges. Out-of-town guests staying with a pool member are not required to use a guest pass to visit the pool. Neighbors, friends, family members living in another home in town, etc. will be considered guests and require a guest pass. Additional guest passes may be purchased from the Basket Room.

**METHOD OF PAYMENT**

Pinon Park Pool accepts payment of membership and volunteer fees by check or cash only. **Due to rising costs and limited demand, we will no longer accept credit cards.** Checks should be made payable to *Pinon Park Pool Association*.

A payment plan may also be set up for an additional \$15 processing fee. The first two payments must be made prior to Opening Day. The third payment is due by June 30, 2015. If the final payment is not received by this date, the membership will be suspended until payment is received.

All payments, or payment plan arrangements, must be made prior to May 1, 2015. **Payments made after May 1, 2015 are subject to a \$75 Late Fee** (except for new members).

**VOLUNTEER HOURS AND FEES**

Each pool membership is required to complete six hours of volunteer time. The volunteer fee is \$75 per membership.

Volunteer hours can be completed at the Opening Work parties, during Wednesday Late Nights, the Closing Work party and during special events throughout the summer. There is also always weeding to be done -- do it at your convenience and notify us of the time you put in!

Although we would prefer to have your time and effort, we understand that, for some, this is not possible. If you know ahead of time that you will not be able to fulfill the six-hour requirement, please indicate this on your assessment form. Your \$75 volunteer fee will be deposited to fund the completion of jobs needed to prepare for Opening Day. If you do not complete all of your volunteer time, your fee will be refunded for the hours worked at a rate of \$12.50 per hour.

Special circumstances regarding the volunteer requirement may be taken into consideration. Please contact the Volunteer Coordinator, Amy Woods, for more information.

**WORK PARTIES**

Opening work parties will be held on **May 2, 9 & 16**. Jobs include cleaning bathrooms, clearing the garage area, putting away the winter pool cover and taking out the summer covers, installing the slides, pulling weeds, cleaning deck furniture, and cleaning the pool. The closing work party dates will be determined toward the end of the pool season, but will most likely be the weekend after Labor Day.

**SWIM LESSONS**

Swim lessons will be held on the following dates from 9:30 am – 10:15 am:

- June 8 – June 12
- June 22 – June 26
- July 6 – July 10
- July 20 – July 24

Lessons cost \$30 for members and \$40 for non-members. Payments must be received prior to the start of class. If payment is not received, participation will be denied. Classes with fewer than five participants may be rescheduled or cancelled. First priority will be given to pool members. Sign-up sheets will be posted in the lobby.

**SPECIAL EVENTS**

The pool will host several special activities throughout the 2015 season, including late night swims, ice cream parties, and the Annual 4th of July festivities. Check out the website for details.
